Anime Trivia — Answer Key

1. C Goku

Goku (Son Goku) is a Saiyan warrior raised on Earth. Dragon Ball Z follows his battles against increasingly powerful enemies. The franchise has been running since 1984.

2. C Spirited Away

Spirited Away (2001), directed by Hayao Miyazaki, won the Academy Award for Best Animated Feature and is the highest-grossing anime film in Japanese box office history.

3. C Hidden Leaf Village (Konoha)

The Hidden Leaf Village (Konohagakure) is located in the Land of Fire. Naruto dreams of becoming Hokage, the leader of the village.

4. C The Straw Hat Pirates

Luffy leads the Straw Hat Pirates on a quest to find the One Piece treasure and become King of the Pirates. One Piece is one of the best-selling manga series of all time.

5. B Death Note

In Death Note, high school student Light Yagami finds a supernatural notebook dropped by the Shinigami Ryuk. Writing a person's name in it causes their death.

6. C Attack on Titan

Attack on Titan (Shingeki no Kyojin) follows humanity's fight against giant Titans. It became one of the most popular and critically acclaimed anime of the 2010s.

7. C Hayao Miyazaki

Hayao Miyazaki co-founded Studio Ghibli in 1985. He is considered one of the greatest animation directors in history and has won multiple awards for his films.

8. B They were killed by demons (except hi...

Tanjiro returns home to find his family slaughtered by demons. His sister Nezuko survives but has been turned into a demon. He becomes a demon slayer to find a cure for her.

9. C Demon Slayer: Mugen Train

Demon Slayer: Mugen Train (2020) earned over \$500 million worldwide, surpassing Spirited Away to become the highest-grossing anime film and the highest-grossing

10. B Deku

Izuku adopts the hero name Deku, which was originally a childhood insult meaning 'useless.' He reclaims it as a symbol of never giving up.

11. C Dragon Balls

The seven Dragon Balls summon the dragon Shenron, who grants wishes. Collecting all seven is a central plot device throughout the Dragon Ball franchise.

12. C Fullmetal Alchemist: Brotherhood

Fullmetal Alchemist: Brotherhood follows brothers Edward and Alphonse Elric, who use alchemy to try to restore their bodies after a failed attempt to resurrect their mother. It is consistently

13. C Volleyball

Haikyuu!! follows Shoyo Hinata and the Karasuno High School volleyball team. The series is credited with sparking a massive increase in volleyball participation in Japan.

14. C Cursed Spirits

Cursed Spirits are born from negative human emotions. Jujutsu sorcerers like Yuji Itadori fight these spirits using cursed energy techniques.

15. A Aincrad

Aincrad is the floating castle in the first game of Sword Art Online, where 10,000 players are trapped and must clear 100 floors to escape. Death in the game means death in real life.

16. C Gainax

Gainax produced Neon Genesis Evangelion in 1995. The series deconstructed the mecha genre and became one of the most influential anime of all time. Director Hideaki Anno later rebuilt

17. B 20-24 minutes

Most anime episodes run approximately 20-24 minutes (filling a 30-minute TV slot with commercials). A typical anime season is 12-13 or 24-26 episodes.

18. C Death Note

Death Note's central conflict is between Light Yagami (who uses the Death Note to kill criminals) and the mysterious detective L (who tries to catch him). Their cat-and-mouse game is one of

19. C Weekly Shonen Jump

Weekly Shonen Jump, published by Shueisha, is the most influential manga magazine in history. Its series have been adapted into many of the most popular anime ever made.

20. C Your Name (Kimi no Na wa)

Your Name (2016) earned over \$380 million worldwide and became a global sensation. It tells the story of two teenagers who mysteriously swap bodies across time and distance.
