Bible Trivia: Miracles in the Bible — Answer Key

1. C Turning water into wine

Jesus turned water into wine at a wedding in Cana of Galilee (John 2:1-11).

2. C Moses

Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the Lord drove the sea back (Exodus 14:21).

3. C Elijah

Elijah challenged the prophets of Baal and the fire of the Lord fell and consumed the sacrifice (1 Kings 18:36-38).

4. D Four days

Lazarus had been in the tomb for four days when Jesus called him out (John 11:17, 43-44).

5. C Hills full of horses and chariots of fire

God opened the servant's eyes and he saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire surrounding Elisha (2 Kings 6:17).

6. B One

Only one of the ten lepers returned to give thanks, and he was a Samaritan (Luke 17:11-19).

7. C Elisha

Elisha made a borrowed iron axhead float by throwing a stick into the water (2 Kings 6:5-7).

8. B Five loaves and two fish

A boy offered five small barley loaves and two fish, which Jesus multiplied to feed the crowd (John 6:9-13).

9. C The battle of Gibeon

During the battle of Gibeon, the sun stood still for about a full day so Israel could complete their victory (Joshua 10:12-14).

10. C A great fish swallowed him

The Lord provided a great fish to swallow Jonah, and he was inside the fish three days and three nights (Jonah 1:17).

11. C Healed a man who was lame from birth

Peter healed a man crippled from birth at the temple gate called Beautiful (Acts 3:1-8).

12. C Peter

People brought the sick into the streets so that Peter's shadow might fall on them as he passed (Acts 5:15).

13. C Restored his sight

Jesus healed blind Bartimaeus near Jericho, restoring his sight (Mark 10:46-52).

14. C Prayed for rain and it came

After a drought lasting three and a half years, Elijah prayed and rain returned to Israel (1 Kings 18:41-45; James 5:17).

15. B He rebuked the wind and waves, and th...

Jesus rebuked the wind and said to the waves, 'Quiet! Be still!' and it was completely calm (Mark 4:39).

16. B Her jar of flour and jug of oil never ran out

The jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry throughout the famine (1 Kings 17:14-16).

17. C Malta

After a shipwreck, Paul was bitten by a viper on the island of Malta but showed no ill effects (Acts 28:1-6).

18. C Your sins are forgiven

Jesus first said 'Son, your sins are forgiven' before telling him to take up his mat (Mark 2:5-12).

19. B His leprosy was healed

Naaman the Syrian commander was cleansed of his leprosy after obeying Elisha's instruction to dip seven times in the Jordan (2 Kings 5:14).

20. B The young man sat up and began to talk

Jesus touched the coffin and said 'Young man, I say to you, get up!' and the dead man sat up and began to talk (Luke 7:14-15).
