Bible Quiz: Multiple Choice — Answer Key

1. B Six

God created the world in six days and rested on the seventh (Genesis 1-2:3). The seventh day was set apart as a day of rest.

2. C Water turned to blood

The first plague was turning the water of the Nile into blood (Exodus 7:14-24).

3. C Saul

Saul, from the tribe of Benjamin, was anointed as Israel's first king by the prophet Samuel (1 Samuel 10:1).

4. B Manna and quail

God provided manna each morning and quail in the evening to feed the Israelites during their forty years in the wilderness (Exodus 16).

5. C Peter

Peter stepped out of the boat and walked on water toward Jesus, but began to sink when he became afraid (Matthew 14:28-31).

6. C Eleven

Jacob had twelve sons total, making Joseph one of twelve brothers. He had eleven brothers (Genesis 35:22-26).

7. B Eden

God placed Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 2:8).

8. C Matthew

The Sermon on the Mount is recorded in Matthew chapters 5 through 7 and includes the Beatitudes and the Lord's Prayer.

9. C Joseph

Joseph interpreted the dream as seven years of plenty followed by seven years of famine (Genesis 41:25-32).

10. C Harp

David played the harp (or lyre in some translations) to soothe King Saul when he was troubled by an evil spirit (1 Samuel 16:23).

11. B Jonah

Jonah was swallowed by a great fish after fleeing from God's command to preach to Nineveh (Jonah 1:17).

12. B Their feet

Jesus washed his disciples' feet as an act of servant leadership (John 13:1-17).

13. C 5,000

Jesus fed about 5,000 men, plus women and children, with five loaves and two fish (Matthew 14:13-21).

14. B They fell down

After the Israelites marched around Jericho for seven days and shouted, the walls fell down flat (Joshua 6:20).

15. C Peter

Peter denied knowing Jesus three times on the night of his arrest, just as Jesus had predicted (Luke 22:54-62).

16. C The Jordan

The Israelites crossed the Jordan River on dry ground under Joshua's leadership (Joshua 3:14-17).

17. B His birthright

Esau sold his birthright as the firstborn to Jacob for bread and lentil stew (Genesis 25:29-34).

18. B He was blinded by a bright light

A light from heaven flashed around Saul and he fell to the ground, blinded, hearing the voice of Jesus (Acts 9:3-9).

19. C Tax collector

Matthew (also called Levi) was a tax collector sitting at his booth when Jesus called him to follow (Matthew 9:9).

20. C Gabriel

The angel Gabriel was sent by God to Nazareth to tell Mary she would conceive and bear a son named Jesus (Luke 1:26-31).
