Bible Trivia: Book of Revelation — Answer Key

1. **C John**
The author identifies himself as John (Revelation 1:1, 1:4, 1:9).
2. **C The island of Patmos**
John was on the island of Patmos 'because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus' (Revelation 1:9).
3. **C Seven**
Jesus dictated letters to seven churches in Asia Minor: Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia, and Laodicea (Revelation 2-3).
4. **B It was neither hot nor cold, but lukewarm**
'Because you are lukewarm, neither hot nor cold, I am about to spit you out of my mouth' (Revelation 3:16).
5. **C Seven**
The scroll was sealed with seven seals, and only the Lamb was found worthy to open them (Revelation 5:1-5).
6. **C The Lamb**
The Lamb who was slain is declared worthy to open the scroll (Revelation 5:9-10).
7. **B Four**
The four horsemen of the apocalypse ride horses colored white, red, black, and pale (Revelation 6:1-8).
8. **D Pale**
The fourth horseman rides a pale horse, and his name is Death, with Hades following close behind (Revelation 6:8).
9. **C 144,000**
144,000 were sealed, 12,000 from each of the twelve tribes of Israel (Revelation 7:4-8).
10. **C There is silence in heaven for about ...**
When the seventh seal was opened, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour (Revelation 8:1).
11. **B A great star called Wormwood**
A great star named Wormwood fell from the sky and made a third of the waters bitter (Revelation 8:10-11).
12. **C 666**
'Let the person who has insight calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man. That number is 666' (Revelation 13:18).
13. **B A great prostitute**
Babylon the Great is described as a great prostitute sitting on many waters (Revelation 17:1).
14. **C Armageddon**
The kings are gathered to the place called Armageddon (Revelation 16:16).
15. **C One thousand years**
An angel seizes Satan and binds him for a thousand years (Revelation 20:2).
16. **B Death and Hades**
Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death (Revelation 20:14).
17. **C The glory of God and the Lamb**
The city does not need the sun or moon because the glory of God gives it light, and the Lamb is its lamp (Revelation 21:23).
18. **D Twelve**
The new Jerusalem has twelve gates, three on each side, with the names of the twelve tribes of Israel (Revelation 21:12-13).
19. **C The tree of life**
The tree of life stands on each side of the river, bearing twelve crops of fruit (Revelation 22:2).
20. **C Yes, I am coming soon**
Jesus' final recorded words in Scripture are 'Yes, I am coming soon' (Revelation 22:20).
