Bible Trivia: Hard Mode — Answer Key

1. C One hundred

Abraham was one hundred years old when Isaac was born, and Sarah was ninety (Genesis 21:5).

2. C Jephthah

Jephthah vowed to sacrifice the first thing that came out of his house if God gave him victory. His daughter came out to meet him (Judges 11:30-40).

3. A Aaron and Miriam

Moses' older siblings were Aaron, who became the first high priest, and Miriam, the prophetess (Exodus 15:20, Numbers 26:59).

4. C Seven

Jesus dictated letters to seven churches in Asia Minor: Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia, and Laodicea (Revelation 2-3).

5. C Elijah

Elijah was taken up by a whirlwind into heaven as chariots of fire and horses of fire appeared (2 Kings 2:11).

6. C Jesus wept (John 11:35)

John 11:35, 'Jesus wept,' is the shortest verse in the KJV and most English translations. Jesus wept at the tomb of his friend Lazarus.

7. C Joseph

Joseph interpreted Pharaoh's dream as seven years of plenty followed by seven years of famine, which led to his appointment as second in command of Egypt (Genesis 41:25-43).

8. D Esther

The book of Esther never mentions God by name, though His providence is clearly at work throughout the story of Esther saving her people.

9. C Ten

God sent ten plagues on Egypt, from water turning to blood through the death of the firstborn (Exodus 7-12).

10. B Saul

Paul was originally called Saul of Tarsus. He was a Pharisee who persecuted Christians before encountering Jesus on the road to Damascus (Acts 9:1-22).

11. C Joseph and Benjamin

Rachel bore two sons to Jacob: Joseph and Benjamin. She died giving birth to Benjamin (Genesis 35:16-19).

12. C Malta

After a shipwreck, Paul was on the island of Malta gathering firewood when a viper bit his hand. The locals expected him to die, but he was unharmed (Acts 28:1-6).

13. C Nathan

The prophet Nathan confronted David with a parable about a rich man stealing a poor man's lamb, then declared 'You are the man!' (2 Samuel 12:1-7).

14. D Four days

When Jesus arrived at Bethany, Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days (John 11:17).

15. B Solomon

Solomon built the first temple in Jerusalem. David desired to build it but God told him that his son would build the house (1 Kings 6:1, 2 Samuel 7:12-13).

16. C Deborah

Deborah served as both a judge and a prophetess. She called Barak to lead the army against Sisera (Judges 4-5).

17. B Nine

The fruit of the Spirit includes nine qualities: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5:22-23).

18. B Amen

Revelation 22:21 ends with 'Amen.' The full verse in the KJV reads: 'The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.'

19. C Solomon

Solomon had 700 wives of royal birth and 300 concubines, and they turned his heart after other gods (1 Kings 11:3).

20. C Methuselah

Methuselah lived 969 years, making him the longest-lived person recorded in Scripture (Genesis 5:27).
