## Bible Trivia for Kids — Answer Key

**1. B Noah**

God told Noah to build the ark because a great flood was coming. Noah, his family, and the animals were safe inside (Genesis 6-7).

**2. C Jesus**

Jesus was born in Bethlehem and laid in a manger because there was no room at the inn (Luke 2:7).

**3. B David**

David was just a young shepherd boy when he defeated the giant Goliath with one smooth stone (1 Samuel 17).

**4. D Light**

God said 'Let there be light' on the very first day of creation (Genesis 1:3).

**5. B Moses**

God used Moses to part the Red Sea so the Israelites could escape from Egypt (Exodus 14:21-22).

**6. B He was swallowed by a great fish**

Jonah ran from God, ended up in a storm at sea, and was swallowed by a great fish for three days and three nights (Jonah 1:17).

**7. C Six days**

God created everything in six days and rested on the seventh day (Genesis 2:2). The seventh day became a day of rest.

**8. B Garden of Eden**

Adam and Eve lived in the Garden of Eden, a perfect place created by God (Genesis 2:8).

**9. C Gold, frankincense, and myrrh**

The wise men from the East brought three gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh (Matthew 2:11).

**10. B Daniel**

Daniel was thrown into the lions' den because he would not stop praying to God. God sent an angel to shut the lions' mouths (Daniel 6:22).

**11. B Two of each**

God told Noah to bring two of every kind of animal onto the ark (Genesis 6:19). Clean animals came in groups of seven, but the basic number was two.

**12. B Fed over five thousand people**

Jesus took five loaves and two fish, blessed them, and fed more than five thousand people with food left over (Matthew 14:17-21).

**13. B Eve**

God created Eve from one of Adam's ribs to be his companion in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 2:21-22).

**14. C A donkey**

Jesus rode a young donkey into Jerusalem while the crowds waved palm branches and shouted praise (Matthew 21:5-9).

**15. C Forty days**

Jesus spent forty days and forty nights fasting in the wilderness, where he was tempted by the devil (Matthew 4:1-2).
