**1. A Part of Your World**

Part of Your World is Ariel's signature ballad, performed in her secret collection of human artifacts.

**2. C Under the Sea**

Under the Sea won the Academy Award for Best Original Song in 1989.

**3. B Let It Go**

Let It Go became a global phenomenon and won the Academy Award for Best Original Song in 2014.

**4. C A Whole New World**

A Whole New World won the Academy Award for Best Original Song in 1993 and remains one of Disney's most beloved duets.

**5. C I Just Can't Wait to Be King**

This upbeat number features young Simba daydreaming about his future reign while evading Zazu.

**6. C Hakuna Matata**

Hakuna Matata became one of the most quoted Disney phrases, meaning 'no worries' in Swahili.

**7. D Beauty and the Beast**

Beauty and the Beast is performed by Mrs. Potts (Angela Lansbury) during the iconic ballroom dance scene.

**8. B Be Our Guest**

Be Our Guest is a lavish musical number where the enchanted castle staff serve Belle an extravagant dinner.

**9. C You're Welcome**

You're Welcome was performed by Dwayne Johnson and written by Lin-Manuel Miranda for Moana (2016).

**10. C Colors of the Wind**

Colors of the Wind won the Academy Award for Best Original Song in 1996.

**11. C Prince Ali**

Prince Ali features the Genie's elaborate parade introducing Aladdin's fake royal identity.

**12. D I'll Make a Man Out of You**

I'll Make a Man Out of You is the training montage song that has become one of Disney's most popular anthems.

**13. B I See the Light**

I See the Light plays during the lantern scene, which is widely considered one of Disney's most romantic sequences.

**14. C The Bare Necessities**

The Bare Necessities was nominated for the Academy Award for Best Original Song in 1968.

**15. D We Don't Talk About Bruno**

We Don't Talk About Bruno reached number one on the Billboard Hot 100, only the second Disney song to do so.

**16. B When You Wish Upon a Star**

When You Wish Upon a Star won the 1941 Academy Award and became the signature song of the Walt Disney Company.

**17. C Supercalifragilisticexpialidocious**

Supercalifragilisticexpialidocious is one of the most recognized songs in film history, from Mary Poppins (1964).

**18. C Remember Me**

Remember Me won the Academy Award for Best Original Song in 2018 and is central to the film's emotional climax.

**19. C The Gospel Truth**

The Gospel Truth opens Hercules with the Muses telling the backstory of the Titans and the gods of Olympus.

Son of Man accompanies the montage showing Tarzan growing from a child into a powerful young man in the jungle.
