1. C Jerry

Tom and Jerry, created by William Hanna and Joseph Barbera in 1940, is one of the longest-running animated franchises in history. The cat-and-mouse rivalry has appeared in over 160

2. C Norville

Shaggy's full name is Norville Rogers. The character was originally voiced by radio DJ Casey Kasem, who played him from 1969 to 1997 and again from 2002 to 2009.

3. C Rugrats

Rugrats premiered on Nickelodeon in 1991, created by Arlene Klasky, Gabor Csupo, and Paul Germain. It ran for nine seasons and spawned three theatrical films.

4. C The Renaissance

Leonardo, Donatello, Raphael, and Michelangelo are named after Renaissance artists. The original comic was created by Kevin Eastman and Peter Laird in 1984, and the animated series

5. C The Flintstones

The Flintstones premiered in 1960 and was the first animated series to air in primetime television. Fred and Wilma Flintstone live next door to Barney and Betty Rubble.

6. C Garfield

Garfield was created by Jim Davis as a comic strip in 1978. The animated series 'Garfield and Friends' ran from 1988 to 1994 on CBS Saturday mornings.

7. C Dee Dee

Dee Dee's playful intrusions into Dexter's secret laboratory drive much of the show's comedy. The series premiered on Cartoon Network in 1996, created by Genndy Tartakovsky.

8. C The Powerpuff Girls

The Powerpuff Girls premiered on Cartoon Network in 1998, created by Craig McCracken. Blossom, Bubbles, and Buttercup protect the city of Townsville from villains like Mojo Jojo.

9. C Patrick

Patrick Star is SpongeBob's loyal but not-too-bright best friend. SpongeBob SquarePants premiered on Nickelodeon in 1999, created by marine science educator Stephen Hillenburg.

10. C Scrooge McDuck

Scrooge McDuck, the richest duck in the world, is famous for swimming in his money vault. DuckTales premiered in 1987 and was Disney's first syndicated animated series.

11. C Elmer Fudd

Elmer Fudd has been hunting Bugs Bunny since 1940. His catchphrase 'Be vewy, vewy quiet. I'm hunting wabbits' is one of the most quoted lines in animation history.

12. C Voltron

Voltron: Defender of the Universe premiered in 1984. Five robot lions piloted by individual heroes combine to form the mighty Voltron to battle the forces of King Zarkon.

13. C Courage

Courage the Cowardly Dog premiered on Cartoon Network in 1999, created by John R. Dilworth. Despite his fears, Courage always finds the bravery to save his owners from supernatural

14. C The Adventures of Jimmy Neutron

The Adventures of Jimmy Neutron: Boy Genius ran on Nickelodeon from 2002 to 2006, following the 2001 CGI film Jimmy Neutron: Boy Genius.

15. C Take over the world

Every episode opens with Pinky asking 'What are we going to do tonight, Brain?' and Brain responding 'The same thing we do every night, Pinky: try to take over the world.' The show spun off

16. C Ed, Edd n Eddy

Ed, Edd n Eddy premiered on Cartoon Network in 1999, created by Danny Antonucci. The three Eds spend their days scheming to scam their neighborhood kids out of quarters to buy

17. C ThunderCats

ThunderCats premiered in 1985, following Lion-O and his fellow Thunderians as they battle the evil Mumm-Ra on Third Earth. Lion-O wields the legendary Sword of Omens.

18. C Hey Arnold!

Hey Arnold! ran from 1996 to 2004, created by Craig Bartlett. Arnold lives with his grandparents Phil and Gertie in their boarding house in the fictional city of Hillwood.

19. C Yakko, Wakko, and Dot

Yakko, Wakko, and Dot Warner are the zany stars of Animaniacs, which premiered in 1993. The show was produced by Steven Spielberg and featured educational segments alongside its

Brave Heart Lion is a Care Bear Cousin who lives in the Forest of Feelings. The Care Bears franchise launched in 1981 as greeting cards before expanding into toys, TV specials, and a 1985
