Percy Jackson Trivia — Answer Key

1. B Poseidon

Percy is the son of Poseidon, god of the sea. This makes Percy a powerful demigod with control over water.

2. B Camp Half-Blood

Camp Half-Blood is located on Long Island, New York, and is protected by a magical barrier. Greek demigods train there to survive in the mortal world.

3. C Grover Underwood

Grover is a satyr (half-human, half-goat) assigned to protect Percy. He dreams of finding the lost god Pan.

4. C Athena

Annabeth is a daughter of Athena, goddess of wisdom and battle strategy. She is incredibly smart and loves architecture.

5. B A sword called Riptide

Riptide (Anaklusmos in Greek) is a celestial bronze sword that disguises itself as a ballpoint pen. It returns to Percy's pocket whenever he loses it.

6. C Zeus' master bolt

Percy is accused of stealing Zeus' lightning bolt, the most powerful weapon in Greek mythology. The quest to return it drives the plot of *The Lightning Thief*.

7. C Kronos

Kronos, the Titan lord and father of the Olympian gods, is the ultimate antagonist. He is slowly rising from Tartarus throughout the series.

8. C A Fury (Mrs. Dodds)

Percy's pre-algebra teacher Mrs. Dodds turns out to be Alecto, one of the three Furies. She attacks Percy during a school field trip to a museum.

9. B Chiron

Chiron is a centaur (half-human, half-horse) and the legendary trainer of heroes. He disguises himself as a wheelchair-bound teacher named Mr. Brunner.

10. C DOA Recording Studios in Los Angeles

In the Percy Jackson universe, the entrance to the Underworld is behind DOA Recording Studios in Los Angeles, guarded by Charon the ferryman.

11. B The Sea of Monsters

The Sea of Monsters follows Percy's quest to find the Golden Fleece to save Camp Half-Blood. The Sea of Monsters is the series' version of the Bermuda Triangle.

12. C Dionysus (Mr. D)

Dionysus was sentenced by Zeus to run Camp Half-Blood as punishment. He goes by 'Mr. D' and constantly gets campers' names wrong on purpose.

13. C A cyclops

Tyson is a young cyclops and a son of Poseidon, making him Percy's half-brother. Despite being gentle, he is incredibly strong.

14. C Annabeth's Yankees cap

Annabeth's Yankees baseball cap was a gift from her mother Athena. It turns the wearer invisible, which comes in handy during many quests.

15. B Above the Empire State Building

In the series, Mount Olympus moves to wherever Western civilization is strongest. Currently it floats above the 600th floor of the Empire State Building in New York.

16. C Tartarus

Tartarus is a prison deep beneath the Underworld. Kronos and other Titans were imprisoned there after the Olympians defeated them.

17. C Luke Castellan

Luke, son of Hermes, becomes Kronos' host and the primary antagonist. He feels abandoned by the gods and recruits other bitter demigods to Kronos' army.

18. C Dyslexia and ADHD

Demigods have dyslexia because their brains are hardwired for ancient Greek, and ADHD because their reflexes are tuned for battlefield awareness.

19. C The Last Olympian

The Last Olympian centers on the final battle between the Olympians and Kronos' army at Manhattan. Percy faces Kronos on the top of the Empire State Building.

20. C River Styx

The River Styx grants near-invulnerability to anyone who survives bathing in it, leaving only one mortal spot. Achilles gained his famous vulnerability this way, and Percy does it too in
