Pokemon Trivia — Answer Key

1. C Pikachu

Ash received Pikachu from Professor Oak because he overslept and the three starter Pokemon had already been taken.

2. C 151

The original Pokemon Red and Blue (Red and Green in Japan) featured 151 Pokemon, from Bulbasaur (#1) to Mew (#151).

3. C Electric

Pikachu is an Electric-type Pokemon. Lightning is not an official Pokemon type. Pikachu evolves into Raichu with a Thunder Stone.

4. B Charmander, Squirtle, Bulbasaur

Players choose between Bulbasaur (Grass/Poison), Charmander (Fire), and Squirtle (Water). Each starter has a type advantage over one of the others.

5. C Team Rocket

Team Rocket is led by Giovanni. The most famous members are Jessie and James, along with their talking Meowth, who constantly try to steal Ash's Pikachu.

6. C Vaporeon

Eevee can evolve into many forms. A Water Stone produces Vaporeon, a Fire Stone produces Flareon, and a Thunder Stone produces Jolteon.

7. C Charizard

Charizard appears on the cover of Pokemon Red (and FireRed). Blastoise appears on the cover of Pokemon Blue (and LeafBlue).

8. C Grass

Grass and Electric types are super effective against Water types. This is one of the core type matchups in the Pokemon battle system.

9. C Gyarados

Magikarp, often considered the weakest Pokemon, evolves into the powerful Gyarados at level 20. The transformation is one of the most dramatic in the franchise.

10. B Poke Ball

The standard Poke Ball is the most basic catching device. There are many variants including Great Balls, Ultra Balls, and the Master Ball, which never fails.

11. C Mewtwo

Mewtwo was cloned from the DNA of the mythical Pokemon Mew. It is one of the most powerful Pokemon in the original games.

12. C Six

Trainers can carry a maximum of six Pokemon in their party. Additional Pokemon are stored in the PC Storage System.

13. C Pallet Town

Ash is from Pallet Town in the Kanto region. Professor Oak's laboratory is also located there.

14. C Dragonite

The evolution line is Dratini, Dragonair, and then Dragonite. Dragonite was the only Dragon-type evolutionary line in Generation I.

15. B Gengar

Gengar is the final evolution of Gastly (Gastly evolves into Haunter, then Gengar via trade). It is a Ghost/Poison type and one of the original 151.

16. B Dark

Dark and Steel types were both introduced in Generation II (Gold and Silver). Dark types are immune to Psychic attacks, addressing the type imbalance from Generation I.

17. C Professor Oak

Professor Samuel Oak is the leading Pokemon researcher in the Kanto region. Each region has its own professor named after a tree.

18. C 18

There are 18 Pokemon types: Normal, Fire, Water, Grass, Electric, Ice, Fighting, Poison, Ground, Flying, Psychic, Bug, Rock, Ghost, Dragon, Dark, Steel, and Fairy.

19. C Ditto

Ditto can use the move Transform to copy the appearance and moves of any opposing Pokemon. It is also commonly used in breeding.

20. B Effort Value

Effort Values (EVs) are hidden stat points gained from battling specific Pokemon. Competitive players train EVs strategically to optimize their team's stats.
