## Taylor Swift Trivia — Answer Key

### 1. C Taylor Swift

Her self-titled debut album 'Taylor Swift' was released in October 2006 when she was 16 years old. It was a country album that launched her career.

### 2. C Country

Taylor started as a country artist signed to Big Machine Records in Nashville. Her first three albums were country or country-pop.

### 3. B 1989

1989, released in 2014, was marketed as her first official pop album. It won the Grammy Award for Album of the Year.

### 4. C Taylor's Version

Taylor is re-recording her first six albums as 'Taylor's Version' to own her master recordings after a dispute over the ownership of her original masters.

### 5. C Four

Taylor has won Album of the Year for Fearless (2010), 1989 (2016), Folklore (2021), and Midnights (2024), making her the only artist to win the award four times.

### 6. C The Eras Tour

The Eras Tour became the highest-grossing concert tour of all time, celebrating her entire discography across different musical eras.

### 7. C Pennsylvania

Taylor grew up in West Reading, Pennsylvania, on a Christmas tree farm. Her family relocated to Nashville when she was 14 to pursue her music career.

### 8. B Speak Now

Taylor wrote every song on Speak Now (2010) by herself, with no co-writers. She was 18 and 19 during the writing process.

### 9. C Folklore and Evermore

Folklore (July 2020) and Evermore (December 2020) were surprise releases during the COVID-19 pandemic. Both featured an indie folk and alternative style.

### 10. C Kanye West

Kanye West interrupted Taylor's acceptance speech for Best Female Video to say Beyonce should have won. The incident became one of the most talked-about moments in awards

### 11. D She does not own a label; she is sign...

Taylor signed with Republic Records (part of Universal Music Group) in 2018 after leaving Big Machine Records. She negotiated ownership of her new masters from that point

### 12. C Red (Taylor's Version)

Red (Taylor's Version) includes a 10-minute version of 'All Too Well,' which became a fan favorite and was accompanied by a short film directed by Taylor.

### 13. A Olivia Benson

Taylor has three cats: Meredith Grey (named after the Grey's Anatomy character), Olivia Benson (named after the Law & Order: SVU character), and Benjamin Button.

### 14. B 1989

Taylor Alicia Swift was born on December 13, 1989, in West Reading, Pennsylvania. Her album '1989' is named after her birth year.

### 15. C Midnights

Midnights, released in October 2022, broke the Spotify record for most streams in a single day. Taylor also occupied the entire top 10 of the Billboard Hot 100 that week.

### 16. C We Are Never Getting Back Together

Despite her massive success, Taylor's first Hot 100 number one was 'We Are Never Getting Back Together' from Red in 2012.

### 17. C Aaron Dessner

Aaron Dessner of The National co-wrote and produced the majority of both Folklore and Evermore. Jack Antonoff also contributed to several tracks.

### 18. B Miss Americana

Miss Americana is a documentary that follows Taylor's personal and creative journey, including her decision to become more politically vocal.

### 19. C Ten

Through Midnights: Taylor Swift, Fearless, Speak Now, Red, 1989, Reputation, Lover, Folklore, Evermore, and Midnights. That is ten original studio albums.

### 20. B Travis Kelce

Taylor Swift and Kansas City Chiefs tight end Travis Kelce began dating in 2023. Her attendance at NFL games became a cultural phenomenon.
